GOAL receives first Global 5000 Jet to be operated by the German Federal Ministry of Defense (FMOD)

Montreal, August 25, 2011 – Today, GOAL German Operating Aircraft Leasing GmbH & Co. KG (GOAL) took delivery of the first *Global 5000* jet to be operated by the German Federal Ministry of Defense (FMOD). In this particular aircraft acquisition project, GOAL is acting as a subcontractor for Lufthansa Technik AG with respect to the acquisition of four *Global 5000* aircraft.

In December 2007, the German Federal Office of Defence Technology and Procurement (BWB) selected the *Global 5000* jet as a key component of their plan for the modernization of the FMOD's Special Mission Wing aircraft fleet. The four *Global 5000* jets, to be completed at Bombardier's *Global Completion Centre* in Montreal before the end of 2011, will be operated by the German FMOD's Special Mission Wing for VIP Transport and Medical Evacuation (MedEvac) flights.

"Compared to the 24 year old Challenger 601s which are in the phaseout process, these new Global 5000s are a huge step forward in terms of travel comfort, speed, range and reliability," said Michael Radunz, Managing Director of GOAL. "We all can be proud to deliver the first aircraft "on-time" and within budget."
